Star of the Sea

Star of the Sea Woman's Shelter is a non-profit organization located in South Jamaica, Queens which provides permanent housing to women who were once homeless.

Founded sixteen years ago by Winnie McCarthy and Alice Ann Elkin, it began as a temporary home for battered women. The program then purchased several abandoned houses for women and children where they could permanently set up home. All residents are expected to get jobs or do volunteer work in the neighborhood.

Today Star of the Sea depends upon donations like ours to help pay for necessary expenses such as utility bills, food, and home repairs. Home repairs are particularly costly since several of the houses were marked for demolition when purchased.

Children's Ministry

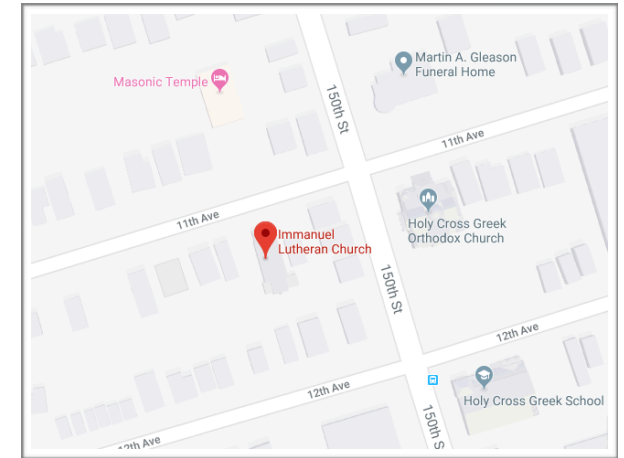
